There are short-growing varieties to plant in pots or containers for the balcony, along the driveway, walks, etc., or taller ones growing up to five feet or more...!

The gorgeous blooms vary in size from two to over ten inches across. Sixteen colour classes and nineteen different forms, shapes or types. So, there is a colour, height and type to suit every gardener!

If one wishes to save/over-winter the tubers, they can be lifted late in the fall and stored, a procedure to be discussed at a later GMDC fall Meeting.
